MANAGING COMMITTEE REPORT

Dear Members,

Your Managing Committee has great pleasure in presenting the 16th Annual Report for RVG Alumni along with the Auditors Report for the financial year ended 31st March, 2024.

Membership Strength

Financial highlights:

During the year, the excess of Income over Expenditure is Rs 17,839 against excess of Income over expenditure of Rs. 84,653 in the previous year.

The Alumni has not charged or charged nominal participation fees etc. from its members. All major programs of the Alumni are sponsored mostly by Alumni members/their offices. The Managing Committee looks forward for continued patronage by its members in sponsoring the programs.

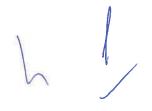

Schedule "K" - Significant Accounting Policies and Notes to Accounts

(A) Significant Accounting Policies

1. Method of Accounting and Revenue Recognition

The accounts have been prepared on accrual basis under the historical cost convention.

2. Membership Fees

Patron Membership Fees, Fellow Membership Fees and Associates Membership Fees are credited to the "Corpus Fund".

3. Corpus Fund

The Corpus Fund amount is transferred to RVG Educational Foundation (Trust) for Investments. As required by bye laws, investments are held in the name of our parent body RVG Educational Foundation "Trust".

4. Depreciation

Depreciation on Fixed Assets is provided at rate prescribed by Income Tax Act, 1961.

5. Revenue Recognition

- a. Revenue is recognised only when it can be reliably measured and it is reasonable to expect ultimate collection.
- b. Sponsorship Fees are accounted for on accrual basis.
